

- 1. Get of Sire shall consist of three doe from a particular sire with not more than one under one year old allowed and not more than one animal from every multiple birth allowed. Get of Sire need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of Sire.
- 2. Produce of Dam shall consist of two doe of different ages, the produce of one dam. Produce of Dam need not be owned by the exihibitor. Entries in this class shall be in the name of the Dam.
- 3. A Dairy Herd- shall consist of three milking doe of one breed, any age.

 4. The Senior Champion class shall consist of all first place winners in the first three classes of Doe one year old and under, in milk, and older animals.

 5. The Junior Champion class shall consist of all first place winners in classes.
- 2 & 3 or Doe one year old and under 2 not in milk and younger animals.
 6. Grand Champion class shall consist of best of breed in each division.
- 7. Only Doe entered in other classes may compete in the Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, and Milking Herd classes.
- 8. No horns of any size on any Dairy Goats, Meat or Market Goats. Only acceptable on the pigmy and Nigerian Dwarf breeds. Horns on these breeds, if they have any length to them, must be monitored very closely to prevent any injuries to spectators, other goats or barn stalls.
- 9. All entries for breed classes are final when the department chairman starts the show catalog. Changes will not be made from one breed class to another once the show catalog is started. If the judge determines on the day of the show that the animal does not meet the breed standards that the animal was entered as, then the animal could be disqualified. Animals must meet the Breed Standards of that breed as set up by the goat association for Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Pygmy Goats and Nigerian Dwarf Goats. The judge's determination is final.

10. Market project goats may not be shown in breeding classes.

Heath Rules:

See rule 3 under Health Rules for all Livestock on page 5. Out of state rabbits see rules 2, 3 and 5 under Health Rules for all Livestock on page 5. All animals must be free of infections and contagious diseases.

- 1. All rabbits are to be judged according to the latest standard of perfection of the American Rabbit Breeders Association but is not an ARBA show.
- 2. All rabbits must have a permanent ear mark in the LEFT ear before arrival at the fair and be owned by the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to.
- 3. "Meat pen" is a pen of three (3) rabbits under 70 days of age, must be of the same breed, variety (color), weigh three (3) pounds minimum, five (5) pounds maximum indivdually. "Stewer" is one (1) rabbit 6 months of age and over, with minimum weight of eight (8) pounds. "Roaster" is one (1) rabbit under 6 months of age not less than 5-1/2 pounds and not over eight pounds. "Single Fryer" is one (1) rabbit not over 10 weeks of age and three (3) to five (5) pounds.
 - 4. Exhibitors must carry own rabbits to and from the show table.
 - 5. NO rabbit is to be brought back onto the grounds once it has left.
 - 6. Entries are not to exceed 25 rabbits (doe & litter counts as one entry).
- 7. Check in will begin at 9 AM on Sunday. ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS BEFORE THE 9 AM CHECK IN. ABSOLUTELY NO DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES.
- 8. If you wish to put a lock on your cage you must use the lock provided by the department chairman.
 - 9. One entry per class.
- 10. Only livestock sale meat pens may compete for Grand & Reserve Grand Banners or be sold at the sale.
