Things to Try at Home

Bubble Trouble Fun with Words Poems

### **Materials:**

- Bubble word patterns
- Pencils, pens, or markers
- Scissors
- Book: *Bubble Trouble* by Joy N. Hulme
- Optional: glue stick and blank paper

### **What to do:**

- Read the book *Bubble Trouble* by Joy N. Hulme.
- Cut out the bubble words and the blank bubbles.
- Arrange the bubble words into a poem.
- Add any extra words on the blank bubble patterns
- Write a bubble poem with your bubble words
- Optional: Glue your bubble poem down on the blank sheet of paper.
- Play with the sounds in your poem. See if you can sing your poem to the tune of a simple song.

### **Talk about:**

- What makes words like bubble trouble sound fun?
- What fun sounds do you hear in the words in your poem?
- Do you use any words with the same sounds in the beginning of the words or at the end of the words?
