Things to Try at Home

Guess Who?

Materials:

- Several favorite story books

What to do:

- Read short quotes or simple dialogue from favorite stories. For the first time, pick a saying that a main character says frequently. Example: Who says, "Little pig, little pig, let me come in...or I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house in" - answer: the big bad wolf from the Three Little Pigs.
- Encourage your child to guess who said the line you read. If necessary, provide hints like "Here's a clue, this character has big bushy ears and pointy teeth"
- If your child can read, take turns reading and guessing with each other. Even children, who cannot read formally, will enjoy asking you who said lines from their favorite books using the pictures as story clues.

Talk about:

Try the game from above using favorite sayings of family members. Who in our family would say, "Feels chilly, better get a sweater."
