

## DIRECTIONS TO THE CHADWICK

One Wexford Square

Wexford, PA 15090

From Route 79:

Take Exit 73 (Wexford) and turn onto Route 910 heading East. Go approximately 2 miles and turn right on to Church Road at a stop sign (Wexford Post Office Deli is on the right). At the next stop sign, turn right on to Route 19 South. Turn right on to Richard Road (McDonald's is on the right). The Chadwick's entrance is the first drive on the right immediately past the McDonald's.

From the PA Turnpike:

Take Exit 28 (Cranberry) and bear right on to Route 19 South. Go approximately 5 miles.
