Liberty Fire Company was dispatched to a person trapped in a skid loader. On arrival, they found an 18 year old male caught between the bucket and the frame of the machine.



How did the PSU ag rescue training help you manage this incident more effectively?

“Because of our ag rescue classes, we were able to better consider our needs (resources) and requested a farm machinery technician to be dispatched to the scene. We constantly monitored the patient to make sure we were not making the situation worse. We used air bags, cribbing, saw-saws, hand tools, and were re-evaluating often to make sure we were progressing appropriately because it was a slow process.”
