From Lebanon

- ▶ Follow Rt. 72 S. through the city.
- ▶ At the Quality Inn intersection, stay to the left fork onto Cornwall Rd.
- ▶ Follow Cornwall Road for 2 miles to the Ag Center.
- ▶ **IF** you miss the Quality Inn intersection, stay on Rt. 72 to the traffic light at the Sheetz intersection.
- ▶ Turn left onto Rocherty Road.
- ▶ Turn Right onto Cornwall Rd. - first building on left.

From the Turnpike

- ▶ Get off at Exit 266 - Lebanon/Lancaster Rt. 72 N.
- ▶ Drive 5.5 miles to the intersection of Quentin Rd. (Rt. 72 and Rocherty Rd.).
- ▶ Turn right.
- ▶ Go to the traffic light at Cornwall Rd.
- ▶ Turn right. Building on your left.

From the Reading Area

- ▶ Go to Lebanon via Rt. 422.
- ▶ At the third traffic light, turn left at Lincoln Ave. to stop sign at Wilhelm Ave.
- ▶ Turn right.
- ▶ Go to the stop sign at Cornwall Rd.
- ▶ Turn left.
- ▶ Drive 1.4 miles.
- ▶ Building on your left.

The "Backyard Gardeners" program is a vegetable study group covering basic to advanced gardening skills following the gardening calendar.
