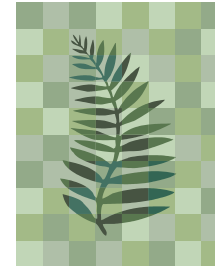

The Penn State Cooperative Extension Master Gardener volunteers utilize research-based information to provide education on best practices in horticulture and environmental stewardship.



To become a Penn State Master Gardener, interested persons must apply and be accepted as a trainee. Trainees must attend **36 hours of instruction, pass the final examination with a minimum score of 80%, and agree to volunteer 50 hours to Penn State Cooperative Extension within one year from successful completion of the basic training. To maintain certification, Master Gardeners must complete 8 hours of additional horticulture training, and commit to a minimum of 20 hours of volunteer service each year. There is a program fee to cover the cost of training materials and expenses.**
