Four Steps to Certify Your Pollinator-friendly Garden

1. Provide food
 - Nectar food sources
 - Larval food sources
2. Provide water
3. Provide shelter
4. Safeguard habitat
 - Remove or don't plant invasive plants
 - Reduce pesticide use
