DEAR 4-H MEMBER:

Welcome to the Adams County Senior Division 4-H Recognition Award Program. This application is your ticket to recognition at the county, state, and national level. 4-H members need to submit this application along with two recommendation forms.

Applicants are eligible for several **County Memorial Awards.** A panel consisting of 4-H alumni and past and present 4-H volunteer leaders, will review applications and select winners. County awards will be presented at 4-H Achievement Night and Leaders Banquet.

Adams County will send two delegates to National 4-H Congress tentatively scheduled in November of the current year. Adams County Extension staff and 4-H Board members will make the selection based on the Recognition Award applications and overall involvement in 4-H. Applicants for National 4-H Congress must be at least 15 years old, as of the current year and at least a third year 4-H member.

Application Criteria

To compete in the Senior Division of the 4-H Recognition Award Program, 4-H members must be 15-18 years of age, as of January 1, of the current program year.

Application Guidelines

- Applicants may compete in up to 4 program areas. Senior Division applicants can be recognized in 1 or 2 program areas.
- Applications include two recommendation forms, at least one of which must be completed by a non 4-H related person (e.g., teacher, employer, counselor, coach, minister, church youth advisor). Do not ask members of your immediate family to complete recommendation forms.
- If typing, please double space.

Application Deadline

Recognition Award applications are **DUE APRIL 1.** Your recommendation letters must be included in your packet or received at the Extension Office by April 1.

Page 1: General Applicant Information

- Sign and date your application.
- Obtain the signatures of a parent/guardian and your 4-H Club Leader.

Page 2: Project Summary

- List completed projects for last three years, including present year.
- Print using proper names of projects (i.e. Foods & Nutrition-Yr. 8 OR "Around the World in Seven Days"). Do NOT write "exhibited muffins, 10 dairy cattle, gun cabinet, 5 vegetables", etc.
- Projects in your program area of competition should be listed first.
- Seniors Must Attach A "Project/Participation Resume"
- Typed resumes are to be single spaced.
- Refer to "Preparing a Resume" handout for additional guidance.
- Junior division entrants DO NOT include a resume with their application.

Impact Question Section

This section includes three short answer questions and one brief essay, dealing with your 4-H experiences. Answers should include events that have shown how 4-H has influenced your life. Think in terms of **IMPACT**. **Be creative!**

Why were these experiences so important to my growth?

What did my club and/or I learn?

Write in paragraph form and use complete sentences. Use ONLY the space provided - DO NOT add pages.

Page 3:

- Communications Question Include your two most important 4-H related COMMUNICATION experiences from the current year and/or two previous years. Ideas include, but are not LIMITED to: talking to a different age group than you are accustomed to; speaking in front of a large audience; creating an exhibit; leading a communications activity for your club; doing research on a controversial topic, etc. How have you benefited from these experiences?
- Leadership Question Discuss your two most important 4-H related LEADERSHIP experiences from current year and/or two previous years. Think about what happened to you or your group, as a result of this experience. What have you learn that helped you become a more effective leader?

Page 4:

- Community Service Question Include your two most important 4-H related COMMUNITY SERVICE experiences from current year and/or two previous years. How did you feel after completing the activities? What did your experience teach you about the importance of community service? These could have been accomplished as a group OR an individual.
- **Essay -** This story should answer the question "How has my 4-H involvement effected my life beyond 4-H?" <u>Use ONLY one side of one page</u>.

Questions to ask yourself:

How have I made a difference in my school, church youth group, sports team, etc. because of my 4-H experiences?

How has 4-H helped me to become more aware of my role as a citizen in my community?

How has 4-H influenced my plans for the future?

Recommendation Forms: Senior applicants need two recommendation forms, at least one of which must be from a non-4-H-related person. Junior level needs 1 completed form. These recommendations may be returned to you for inclusion with your application, or sent directly to the 4-H Staff, if the writer prefers.

DEADLINE: April 1. Recommendation forms must be included with your application, or received by the April 1, deadline.

Adams County 4-H Recognition Award Program Preparing Your Resume

Requirements for 4-H Awards:

- A 4-H resume must be submitted with all senior level recognition applications.
- Records from current year, as well as last two years, should be included.
- Anyone serious about seeking an award must submit an organized, clear, concise, up-to-date, and well-prepared resume.

What is a 4-H resume?

- A summary of a person's 4-H records
- A personal data sheet and summary of important facts about the applicant
- A summary of information a judge would like to know about the applicant

Why is a resume important?

- It serves as an introduction.
- It gives facts that help a judge decide whether or not to select an applicant.
- It demonstrates that the applicant is organized, prepared, and serious about receiving the award.
- Can be used in regional and state competitions.
- It provides practical experience and preparation for entering the job market or applying for scholarships.

How do I prepare a resume?

 Make a list of words that best describe you. The list will help you evaluate your skills, abilities, and interests in the program area more objectively. Place a check next to the action words and phrases that best describe you.

• Your resume should reflect your abilities and qualifications. It should highlight the important events, recognition, leadership experiences, etc. of your last three years. Select data which best represents your qualifications for the program area.

List in order of preference the program area(s) for which you wish to be considered. Applicants may apply for two award areas but win in one area. 4-H'ers are not able to win in the same program area two consecutive years while in the same age level.

Club History:

Organize your club history by listing: clubs you belonged to in last three years offices held - responsibilities and duties

Other Honors:

Awards, achievements, and recognition outside of 4-H Membership in clubs and/or organizations outside of 4-H

Normally, names and addresses of references are listed at the end of the resume. There is no need to list these again, since recommendation forms will be included in your application packet or mailed directly to Darlene.

Resume Review -

- Keep it short one side of one page, single-space
- Keep it simple and easy-to-follow
- Keep it organized and neat
- Keep it accurate, factual and current
- · Keep it on target focus on the program area in which you are applying




