



Bedford County Junior Livestock Sale Scholarship Application

General Requirements

- You must sell an animal through the junior livestock sale at the Bedford County Fair the year in which you apply.
- You must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program and must attach proof of enrollment to this form. (copy of tuition bill, I.D. card, or class schedule)
- Scholarship amount will be prorated based on the number of years selling a market animal (up to four years) and the amount of funds available for a given year.
- Application forms are due in the **Extension Office, 120 W. John Street, Suite 2, Bedford, PA 15522 no later than October 1** of the current year.
- Scholarships will be issued around January 1.
- You may only receive this scholarship one time.
