

The Oracle

Line up 3 students, facing the audience, the back one should stand the middle one should kneel and the front one should sit.

The oracle can move its 6 arms in order to give it a mystical appearance. Move the arms when speaking and let the arms rest by your sides when finished answering the question.

Have students from the audience ask the oracle a question. Each person forming the oracle may only use one word until the question is answered.
